IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
<b>Tanker/Vehicle Accident</b>	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. <b>Call the emergency services: Dial 111</b>
<b>Spill or leak</b>	Do NOT touch or walk through spilled material. Wear PVC overalls, chemical resistant gloves, facemask or goggles. Stop leak when safe to do so. Prevent entry into waterways, drains, or confined areas. Adsorb spilled product and place in sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Absorb and collect washings and place in the same sealable container for disposal. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal.
<b>Fire</b>	<b>Call the Fire Service: Dial 111.</b> Not flammable. Decomposition products in a fire are toxic and or irritant. When fighting a major fire wear an air-supplied respirator. Wear protective equipment. Extinguish warehouse and factory fires using dry chemical extinguisher, foam, carbon dioxide or water spray. DO NOT use direct jet of water. Cool sealed drums with water to prevent rupture due to thermal expansion. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away.

**FIRST AID**

<b>If Swallowed</b>	DO NOT induce vomiting. <b>For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately.</b>
<b>If in Eyes</b>	Hold eyelids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention.
<b>If on Skin</b>	If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water. Do not scrub the skin.
<b>If Inhaled</b>	Remove patient to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-nose. Get medical attention if symptoms develop.

**STORAGE AND SEGREGATION**

**Storage:** Keep out of reach of children. Keep in original containers and tightly closed. Keep away from food, drink and animal feeding stuffs. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated place and protect from sunlight.

**Aggregate Storage Volume Thresholds:** When stored with substances of the same hazard the aggregate quantity must be considered. For full details refer to the current NZS8409 Management of Agrichemicals and the HSNO Regulations.
