**EMERGENCY PROCEDURES** **24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY: 0800 944 955**

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
<b>Tanker/Vehicle Accident</b>	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. <b>Call the Emergency Services: Dial 111.</b>
<b>Spill or leak</b>	Prevent further spillage and product from entering waterways. Wear overalls, gloves, footwear and goggles. Absorb spill with an inert absorbent material (e.g. vermiculite) and place in sealable container for disposal. Wash affected area with water and detergent. Absorb and collect washings and place in the same sealable container as the spilled material. Dispose of the waste safely in suitable landfill.
<b>Fire</b>	<b>Call the Fire Service: Dial 111.</b> Wear protective clothing and self-contained breathing apparatus. During a fire toxic fumes may be released. Extinguish fires with water spray, carbon dioxide, foam or dry extinguishing media. Keep non-involved persons away.

**FIRST AID**

<b>If Swallowed:</b>	Rinse mouth immediately and then drink plenty of water, seek medical attention. Do NOT induce vomiting. <b>For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISONS (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately.</b>
<b>If in Eyes:</b>	Immediately wash affected eyes for at least 15 minutes under running water with eyelids held open. Get medical attention.
<b>If on Skin:</b>	If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water. Do NOT scrub the skin. Wash clothing before reuse. If irritation persists get medical attention.
<b>If Inhaled:</b>	Remove patient to fresh air. Get medical attention.

**STORAGE AND SEGREGATION**

**Storage:** Store in the closed, original container, in a well-ventilated area, as cool as possible. Keep away from heat. Protect from direct sunlight. Avoid temperatures below 0°C.

**AGGREGATE STORAGE VOLUME THRESHOLDS:** When stored with substances of the same hazard the aggregate quantity must be considered. For full details refer to the current standard NZS8409 Management of Agrichemicals or the HSNO Regulations.

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**Segregation:** In store separate by at least 5 metres, on transport separate by at least 3 metres, in both cases horizontally. On vehicles a segregation device may be used: Check the Land Transport Rule Dangerous Goods, Rule 45001 for additional information. Sea transport may require additional segregation. Refer to NZS5433 Sea Segregation for details.
