IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
Vehicle accident	Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Call the emergency services on 111.
Spill or leak	In case of spillage it is important to take all steps necessary to avoid eye and skin contact, wear appropriate protective clothing and prevent material from entering water ways. Absorb spills with inert material and place in waste containers. Wash area with water and absorb with further inert material. Dispose of waste safely. Avoid contamination of any water supply with product or empty container. Avoid release to the environment.
Fire	Call the Fire Service on 111. Keep non-involved persons clear. Wear PVC protective clothing and breathing apparatus. Extinguish fires using water spray/fog, foam, dry chemical or carbon dioxide. Contain runoff and treat as for Spillage above.

FIRST AID

If swallowed	DO NOT induce vomiting. For advice contact a doctor or the National Poisons Centre on 0800 POISON (0800 764 766), or a doctor immediately.
If in eyes	Hold eyelids apart and flush continuously with running water for at least 5 minutes. Get medical attention.
If on skin	Remove contaminated clothing, flush skin with running water. Do not scrub skin.
If inhaled	Remove affected person to fresh air. Get medical attention for any symptoms that develop.

STORAGE AND SEGREGATION

Storage: Store in original container, tightly closed, away from direct sunlight, in a cool, dry place. Avoiding temperatures below 0°C and above 35 °C. Do not store with food. Keep out of reach of children.

Aggregate Storage Volume Thresholds: When stored with substances of the same hazard the aggregate quantity must be considered. Refer to NZS8409 Management of Agrichemicals and the HSNO Regulations for full details.
